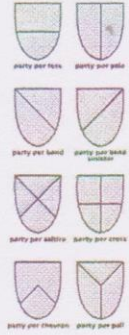


Make your own Coat of Arms



1. Chose a partition for the background lines. You may use any of the designs to the right or create a design of your own.

2. Choose a combination of the following colors that best represent who you are to color the background of your shield.

Gold- generosity
 Black- Constancy/Dependability
 Red- Military fortitude and magnanimity
 Purple- royal majesty, justice

Silver- Peace and sincerity
 Blue- Loyalty and truthfulness
 Green- hope, joy, loyalty
 Orange- ambition

3. Draw an animal as part of your design.

Bear- protectiveness
 Camel- perseverance
 Eagle- leadership and decisiveness
 Falcon or hawk- eagerness
 Griffin- (part eagle, part lion) bravery
 Lion- courage
 Raven- constancy
 Stag, elk or deer- peace and harmony
 Unicorn- extreme courage

Bee- industrious
 Dog- loyalty
 Dragon- defender
 Fox- cleverness
 Horse- readiness to serve
 Pelican- generosity and devotion
 Snake- ambition
 Tiger- fierceness and valor
 Wolf- constant vigilance

4. Put a symbol on your shield that represents your position in your family

Oldest- castle
 Third- five pointed star
 *if your further down the line in your family make up your own symbol

Second- crescent or new moon
 Fourth- bird

5. Include your name or what you would like to be called on your shield.

6. Neatness: completely colored, written and done neatly

7. Description on the back: On the back of your shield write down the colors you used and what they mean, the animal you drew and what it means, your family position symbol and your full name.
