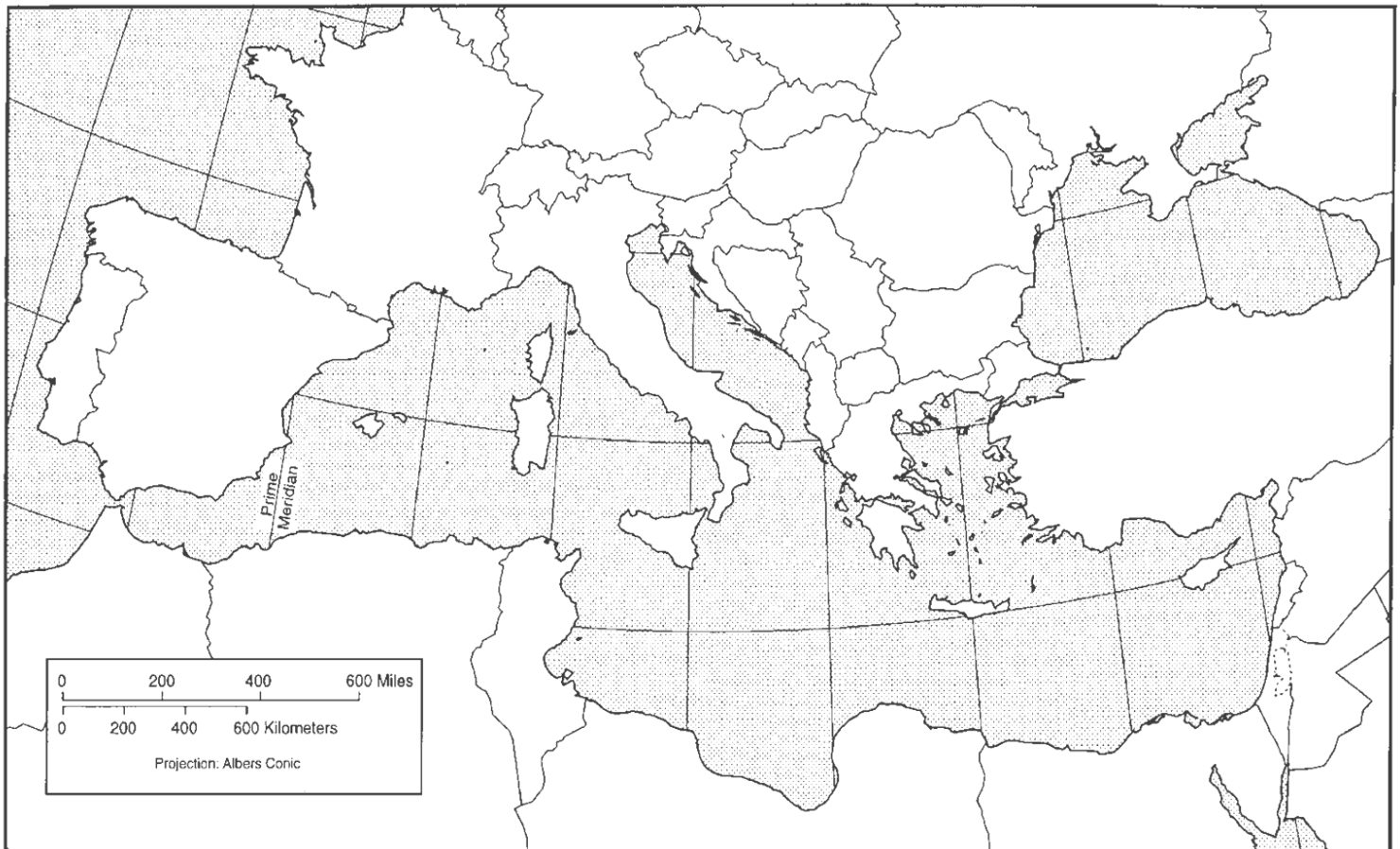


### Geography of the Roman Empire
